### **MINNESOTA APPLE CAKE**

2 eggs, beaten
2 c. sugar
1 c. oil
4 c. chopped apples
2 1/2 c. flour
1 tsp. salt
1 tsp. cinnamon
2 tsp. baking soda

Combine eggs, sugar, oil and chopped apples: let stand 20 minutes. Combine flour, salt, cinnamon and soda and add to apple mixture. Pour into greased and floured Bundt pan. Bake at 350° for 1 hour.




